UNIVERSAL DATA ELEMENTS, CLIENT LEVEL

Replacing 'Client refused' with 'Client prefers not to answer' in all elements.

'Client Location' is going to be called 'Enrolment CoC'

Race & Ethnicity – will be combined into 1 element.

- Adding "Hispanic/Latina/e/o" & "Middle Eastern or North African" to the response options under Race.
- Will be able to select multiple response options.

Gender has been updated & added to.

- Changing the words "Female" & "Male" to "Woman" & "Man."
- "Gender other than..." is changing to "Non-Binary"
- Adding "Culturally specific identity" and "different identity" to the options.
 - ➤ This is all intended to create a less medical or clinical tone to the questions.

Exit Destination – Reorganized & with more options.

- Separating Temporary & Permanent situations. Both will still be under Exit Destinations, just sectioned under different headers.
- Other Exit options are reorganized and numbered.
 - This was done to make data collection easier & more intuitive than the current setup.

Living Situation – Prior, Current, & Exit Destination

Combining subsidy types in Permanent Situations into "rent/own by the client with ongoing subsidy."

Adding a dependency that allows for the selection of subsidy type.

Translation Assistance Needed/Language Option

- Identifies clients needing translation assistance & in what language. This Language will be chosen from the new Appendix.
- A new Appendix of the 20 most common languages in our CoC. There will be an "Other" option.
